The History of Loudwater Farm

The Farm was discovered in 1971 by local Subud members looking for a Latihan venue near Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire, UK, just outside London.

The building and grounds were restored and extended over the next 40 plus years and the place now serves Subud members locally, nationally and worldwide.

There are 2 substantial Latihan Halls, an old barn and smaller forge. In addition there are 9 guest rooms, mostly twin-bedded and a 5-bed dormitory as well as a self-contained 2 room apartment – all in beautiful grounds of around 2 hectares, surrounded by a quiet river forming the boundary.

Loudwater Farm Activities

As well as being a venue for Subud activities, meetings, gatherings and family holidays, the Farm covers its costs by being a local amenity centre for local residents, yoga groups, therapists and various residential weekend retreats.
